No one intends to cause problems socially using alcohol or other drugs; nor does anyone intend to become addicted. But when it happens, it's important to get

help right away. There are very effective treatment options to help people recover and heal from substance-use. If you or someone you care about may be suffering, RECOVERY CONNECT can help.

Alcohol and other drug use touches all of us.

It is not an issue of self-control, race, gender, morals, social or economic conditions. Nearly 80% of people with alcohol problems are employed. 1.8 million Veterans of any age meet the criteria for having a substance abuse disorder in 2006. The rate of current use of illicit drugs among young adults aged 18 - 25 increased from 19.6 percent in 2008 to 21.2 percent in 2009 and 21.5 percent in 2010.
